Sieving through the Sands: Which Grant is for Me?

Aims

To provide a highly interactive platform (Interactive Grant Calendar System- IGCS) that effectively and efficiently provides all necessary grant information available and at the same time sieves out grants and its related information that the user is eligible for.



Methodology

Surveys were done pre- and post-implementation of the IGCS, specifically focusing on the time spent to find grant information. The surveys provided assessments 'on time spent to find necessary information', 'difficulty levels', 'user friendliness' and 'likelihood of future use'.

Root cause analysis was also performed using the Ishikawa diagram, where the major causes contributing to the problem was identified.

Based on the prior, the team have then come up with the IGCS that provides grant information as well as does eligibility criteria checks.




Results

With the IGCS, the percentage of researchers and principal investigators who took more than 5 minutes to find grant information to determine which grant to apply for has statistically significantly reduced from 87% to 30%.

In addition, with the introduction of the IGCS, the difficulty rating decreased from 37% to 3%, user friendliness of the system increase from 0% to 37% and the 'most likely to use' rating increased from 7% to 47%.


Positive feedback were also received from the research community on the implementation on the IGCS.
