100% Elimination of Paper Waste from Normal General X-ray Reports

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BACKGROUND

Normal reports that require no further intervention are printed out, sorted and filed into the respective patient case-notes stored at Medical Records Office.

An average of 20 Normal General X-ray reports are printed and filed in a day. In a week, there are up to 100 print-outs.

These are redundant steps as finalised reports are electronically available on Citrix SCM for viewing by the referring clinician.

Why print Normal Report? The ask why technique was used to drill deeper into the reason for the practice of printing hard copies of the normal reports. It was found that the normal reports are being printed due to doctors' preference in reading hard copy reports.

Feedback was consolidated from senior consultant doctors (Cardiology and Cardiothoracic Surgery Division) on eliminating the printing of Normal General X-ray reports completely.

In alignment to NHCS goals to be a digital hospital, actions are to be taken to change the process of printing normal reports to reduce waste.




