

# Impact on Implantable Cardioverter Defibrillator implantation rate following establishment of Cardiac Implantable Electronic Device Team

### Introduction



- \* Implantable Cardioverter Defibrillators (ICDs) improve survival for both primary and secondary prevention of sudden cardiac arrest.
- \* However, the ICD uptake rate in our institution is poor (30%) primarily due to patients' indecision and apprehension of ICD procedure.
- Accordingly, cardiac implantable electronic device (CIED) team was established in November 2014 in order to improve patient acceptance rate by providing counseling and feedback.
- Hence, this study is to evaluate the implication of establishment of CIED team on ICD implantation rate

## Methodology

All patients who require ICD for primary or secondary prevention of sudden cardiac arrest

Sep 2012 – Oct 2014

Nov 2014 – Dec 2016

All new ICD and Cardiac Resynchronisation Therapy Defibrillator cases

**Exclusion Criteria** 

Patients who underwent ICD pulse generator changes or device upgrading



#### Results

- There was a total of 126 new ICD device implanted (4.8 cases per month) prior to CIED team formation as compared to 135 new ICD device implanted (5.2 cases) following CIED team establishment.
- Moreover, with the establishment of CIED team as well as dedicated telephone line (during office hour), we were able to provide instant feedback on patients' concern before and after device implantation.
- Patients' apprehensions regarding the ICD procedure were greatly reduced.

#### Limitations

- Relatively short period of study
- Unable to gather the data on patients' response pre and post-CIED team formation as this is a retrospective study. However, we provide point of contact to patients with the CIED team and believe patients'apprehensions on ICD procedure were greatly reduced.

## Conclusion

With the establishment of CIED team, the ICD acceptance rate was clearly improved within relatively a short period of time.
