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Adding years of healthy life

As a background, the sourcing process in public healthcare had been highly administrative and manual. In 2013, NHG GPO had successfully led the implementation of E-Procurement system, with Electronic Sourcing for the NHG, NUHS and AHS Clusters/Institutions ("NNA"). NNA is the first mover to implement Electronic Sourcing in the public healthcare sourcing landscape.

The aims of this Project is to improve work efficiency, governance and align the sourcing processes among NNA Clusters/Institutions.

METHODOLOGY

The deployment for this Project was massive and required detailed planning at each stage - from process mapping, to Supplier summit, to onsite training, to ensure success.

(a) Alignment to a Single Process

Workshops were being conducted to map the current process to future state of electronic sourcing. This allowed NNA to review and align various processes to a single streamlined electronic sourcing process.

(b) Governance

While transforming the way NNA source, constant reviews were conducted to ensure that Electronic Sourcing strengthens and automates the governance requirements while driving work efficiency.

(c) Supplier On-Boarding

Suppliers' base were stratified and prioritized in the initial on-boarding process. Supplier summits were held to communicate to the Suppliers on this Electronic initiative and to encourage registration.

(d) Change Management

Electronic Sourcing was rolled out in 3 Phases, spanning across 9 Hospitals/Institutions. Processes were fine-tuned and adjusted in each roll out. There were regular communications, road shows and trainings to ensure buyers were prepared and familiar with the new processes.

RESULTS

The key areas transformed through implementation of Electronic Sourcing are as follows:

Single and Streamlined Electronic Platform

All Request for Quotation (RFQ)/Request for Proposal (RFP)/Tender (collectively, "RFX") postings by NNA Clusters/Institutions are streamlined to one single platform. Suppliers can view all healthcare business opportunities in this single platform.

Reduction in Administrative Steps

- Buyers no longer have to manually prepare multiple sets of RFP/Tender documents, collect RFP/Tender document fees from Suppliers and stamp/endorse on the Suppliers' pricing submissions.
- Suppliers need not make multiple trips to the Hospitals/Institutions for collection and submission of RFPs/Tenders.

Strengthening of Governance Control

- Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA), RFP/Tender fees collection and closing date and time of RFPs/Tenders can be administered and tracked via the system.
- There are traceability in terms of dates and times stamped on the Suppliers' submissions.

Promote Environmental Sustainability

Hard copy RFP/Tender submissions are no longer required in most submissions. This has significantly reduced paper wastage and in turn conserved our environment.

CONCLUSION

A year from implementation, NNA's Electronic Sourcing portal has supported an online community of close to 2,000 Suppliers and 2,079 RFXs. This translated to 173 RFXs called in a month. Electronic Sourcing has transformed the NNA's Healthcare Sourcing Landscape, from highly manual to electronic process. The change management has improved the overall productivity, environmental sustainability and governance of healthcare sourcing process.
