Speedy Response - How 3 Agencies Collaborate to Deliver 1000 units of Haze Equipment to 80 ILTC Providers

Background

Haze hit Singapore annually around June and haze particles greatly affect the heart & lungs especially people who have chronic heart & lungs diseases and the elderly.

In end November 2013, Ministry of Health (MOH) and Agency for Integrated Care (AIC) engaged SingHealth Group Procurement Office (GPO) to purchase the haze equipment for 80 Intermediate & Long-Term Care (ILTC) providers in preparation for the next wave of haze by April 2014.

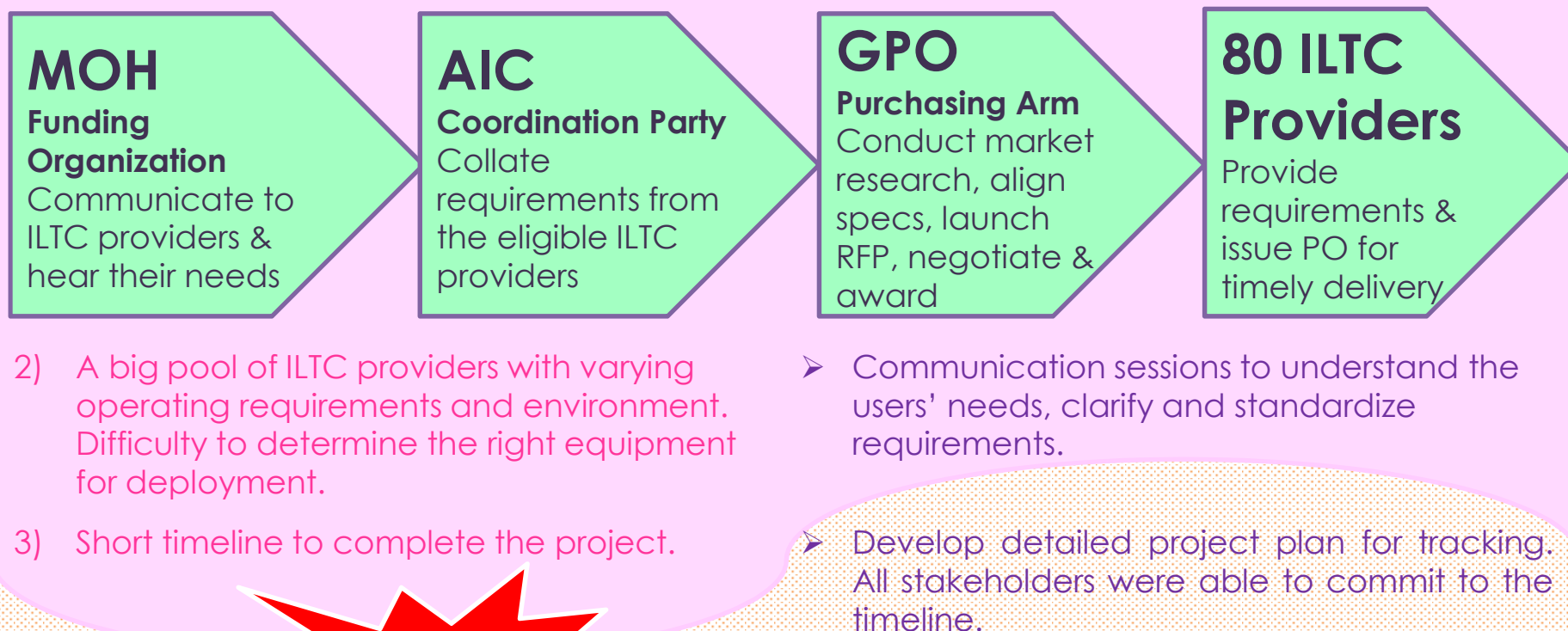
Methodology

- 1) Multiple organizations were involved and a need to clearly define the roles and responsibilities.

Our Approach

- Each organization was assigned specific role for execution.



Result

Success!

- ✓ The project was completed in February 2014, 3 months ahead of the haze season.
- ✓ Together, we achieved approximately 3% savings through economies of scale and strengthened governance.
- ✓ The ILTC providers were able to receive their equipment ahead of time and deploy for use should the haze return this year.
