





We hope to improve the lives of patients with Rheumatological diseases through raising awareness on these conditions and raising funds for research.


Swim For Rheumatology! in 2017 was inaugurated with these objectives in mind.

5. Community and Corporate Partnerships

Partnered with schools (e.g. ACS and MGS), Keppel Club, Goldman Sachs and national swimmers for wider community outreach.



6. Event Publicity

Leveraged on print media, social media, and internal platforms to raise awareness and garner participation from public and staff.

Results & Outreach

128 swimmers swam **5,256 laps** at Keppel Club



Information on Rheumatological diseases, ongoing research initiatives, patient stories, and media coverage on the event were featured in print media, television and radio interviews, Yahoo news and SGH Facebook page.

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over **\$240,000** was raised for the Reverie Rheumatology Research Fund under Medicine ACP, exceeding our initial target of \$100,000
