Objectives:

- To improve the traceability of defective product reports, reduce the time required to sort out hard copy forms and products
- To eliminate creating an untidy work environment.

3. Clear segregation of defective items and normal items to prevent mixed up.

4. Better facilitate the collection of exchanged items.


Methodology
