## REDUCE THE NUMBER OF TOGGLES INTO ELECTRONIC MEDICAL RECORD SYSTEM FOR TRACING BLOOD RESULTS IN AN AMBULATORY CHEMOTHERAPY TREATMENT UNIT

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#### INTRODUCTION

One of the challenges faced in Ambulatory Treatment Unit (ATU) is the time taken for tracing patient's blood test results prior to receiving chemotherapy in the Unit. Nurses need to toggle between various management systems which is very time consuming leading to decreased efficiency in tracing these results. The notion of embarking on this project is to enhance the efficacy of tracing blood test results for patients receiving chemotherapy at ATU.

METHODLOGY

 Creation of Dashboard for Display Alert
 Cancer Informatics created visual cue in the MOSAIQ – Oncology Practice Management System

#### OBJECTIVES

This project aims to create a visual cue dashboard for the ATU's Screening Nurses. The dashboard served as an alert for the nurses when individual patient's blood test results are ready in the Electronic Medical Records.

**Desired outcomes are:** 

- Eliminating the waste (multiple toggling of systems)
- Reducing the time taken for screening individual patient's blood test results
- Reducing the patient's waiting time for screening process
- Eradicating the risk of 'missed' tracing of patient's blood test results causing a delay in patient's chemotherapy appointment time

### ATU Dashboard (Screening)



Improving on the timeliness of patients receiving their chemotherapy

#### GAPS ANALYSIS

- Time wasted for nurses to toggle between Virtual Key Pad (VKP - queue system for screening blood test results) and Sunrise Clinical Manager (SCM - report of blood test results)
- No visual cue to alert nurses that the blood test results are ready
- Failure to know when the blood test results are ready leading to a delay in the transfer of queue number to the counter staff for

registration
