



Eye Clinic Nurse Led Pre-Operative Assessment Improves Cataract Surgery Lead Time, Reduces Anaesthesia Clinic Workload & Improves Satisfaction

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
Background

Cataract surgery (CS) is the most frequent procedure listed in the Eye Clinic. The patient conventionally will get a separate day Anesthesia Clinic (AC) appointment (often with a long lead time) for Pre-Operative Assessment (POA) by the doctor & diagnostic testing.

We transformed a care model for selective patients to do Cataract Surgery under Topical Anesthesia (CSUTA). It involves a trained nurse to do same-day POA in Eye Clinic upon listing & negating all diagnostic testing.

Methodology

Brainstorming by all 3 departments to derive at the workflow, inclusion & exclusion criteria for suitable CSUTA cases.



Inclusion criteria

- ASA physical status 1-3
- Pain threshold
- Cooperation
- Able to obey
 commands to fix eye
 gaze
- Patient who has received full explanation
- Understand risks and benefits of various eye anesthesia

Exclusion criteria

- ASA physical status 4
- Any heart condition
- Recent AMI, CVA or TIA (< 3months)
- Severe chronic obstructive lung disease
- Uncontrolled hypertension (> 170/90mmHg)
- Uncontrolled Diabetes (> 16mmol/L random BSL)
- Warfarin therapy
- Anxious patient
- Severe hearing or mental impairment


Surgery Lead Time:

Cases Type	TA cases	RA cases
Pre-op Assessment	Same-day	0-14 days
Cataract Surgery	2 weeks	From 1 month

Pre-op Assessment Patient Cost Savings:


- Total patients' savings (2013 until Jan 2016) = \$77 x 804 = \$61,908
- Workload reduction for AC (FY 13 FY 16 of Jan): 11.1%



Patient Satisfaction:

6-question survey

- Care Model, Clinic
 Service, Nurse
 Service, Waiting Time
 & POA Bill Size
- Likert score 1-5; 1: dissatisfied, 5: very satisfied)



- OVS Department: increase total CS volume & revenue, OT utilisation, reduce CS lead time & less cancellations, elevates nursing profile.
- Patient: lower POA & CS bill size, 1 visit less, faster surgery, obviates regional anesthesia risks.

Conclusion

❖ Eye Clinic Nurse-Led POA shortens CS lead time, lowers POA cost, negates additional AC visits & improves satisfaction in patients for CSUTA.

Results

 Total number of CSUTA cases in Day Surgery Centre from FY 2013 to January 2016: <u>804 cases</u>
